



Karapiro Catchment - Riparian Planting Project



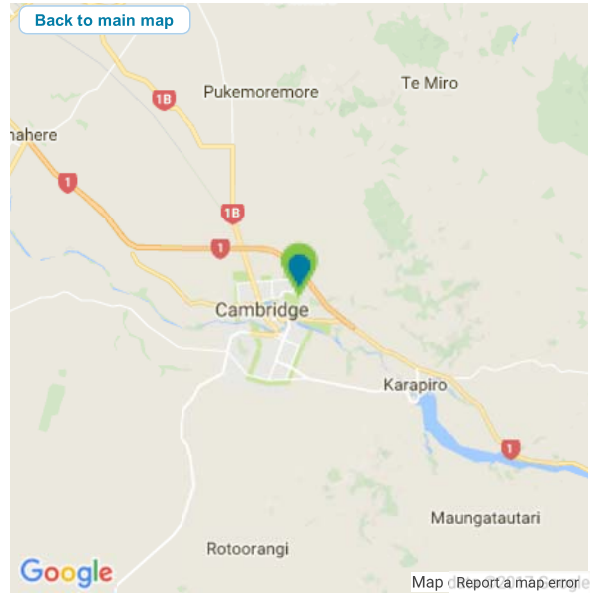

The aim of this project is to restore and protect an erosion prone area of the Karapiro river system.

This project covers an area of approximately 5.5 hectares in the Karapiro area. The Karapiro river system is erosion prone due to poor bank stabilisation and this project will see to mitigate that on a 2km portion of it.

This project will link two other projects currently being worked on by the Ngati Haua Mahi Trust – the WRA 13-055 project, downstream, and the HEB/Opus Planting project below the newly constructed bridge upstream. This proposed 3-year project plan will see approximately 40,000 eco-sourced trees planted into the riparian margin. WRA 15-010.
