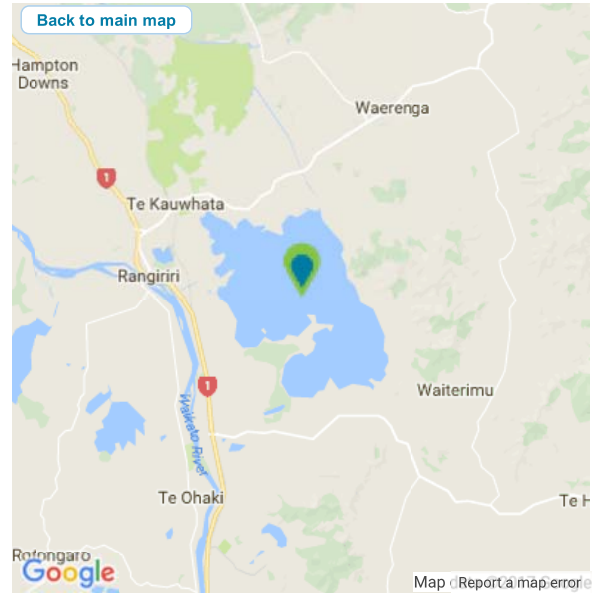
Identify interventions to protect and restore the Whangamarino Wetland.

The purpose of this project is to identify interventions to protect and restore the Whangamarino Wetland.

Using a wetland systems approach and advanced optioneering, the key goals of the project are to:

- assess sediment and contaminant management related (sediment, nutrients, microbiological and flow / level controls) projects/options to determine the full spectrum of intervention required to meet the Vision and Strategy of the Waikato and Waipa Rivers within the Whangamarino Wetland
- identify the additional system-wide initiatives required to achieve wetland objectives
- draft project scopes for newly developed projects
- integrate with existing implementation strategies and prioritise the newly developed projects using the INFERR methodology.
